Terms of Sale

1. Animals become the property of the buyer upon completion of the sale. Normal care of the animals will be the responsibility of the contributor while the animals are on the grounds.
2. Animals will be delivered to the processing plant listed at no cost to the purchaser.
3. Purchaser is responsible for killing costs, delivery charges to a butcher and all costs of cutting, wrapping and freezing.
4. Settlement for purchase of the animal must be made immediately after the sale with the sale cashier unless prior arrangements have been made.
5. Terms are cash or cheque unless suitable credit arrangements are made prior to the sale.
