Application Requirements:

- \$150 registration fee - payable to 4-H Canada (once selected for the exchange)

Applications are to be submitted to a District Key Leader, by above deadline. All applicants that meet the requirements will be interviewed.

Dates of the exchange will be one of the following:

- Tuesday, June 30 to Thursday, July 9
- Saturday, July 18 to Monday, July 27
- Tuesday, August 4 to Thursday, August 13

The group that South Malahat will be hosting will be coming one of the above weeks.
